# **Preliminary Operating Statistics**



## For the 1st Quarter 2020

PT AirAsia Indonesia Tbk ("AAID" or "the Company") is pleased to announce the operating statistics for the first quarter of the financial year ("1Q20").

The Company posted a load factor of 74% for 1Q20, down by 14 percentage points ("ppt") as passengers carried fell by 7% year-on-year ("YoY") to 1.7 million due to COVID-19 pandemic which affected travel demand. Revenue Passenger Kilometres ("RPK") also fell by 18%, greater than the fall in Available Seat Kilometres ("ASK") for the period. The Company launched 1 new route namely Jakarta-Medan with no addition to the fleet in the quarter. The Company temporarily suspended all airline operations as at 1st April 2020 in support of the government's effort to reduce the spread of coronavirus.
