



# Preliminary Operating Statistics

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2019

PT AirAsia Indonesia Tbk (“AAID” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce the operating statistics for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of the Financial Year 2019 (“2Q19”).

The Company posted a load factor of 82%, up 1 percentage points (“ppts”) as a result of faster growth in passengers carried than capacity which was up by 58% and 56% respectively as compared to the same period last year. Available Seat Kilometres (“ASK”) grew by 58%, in line with Revenue Passengers Kilometres (“RPK”) during the quarter under review. Second quarter is traditionally a busy season due to Lebaran and school holidays with the company increasing frequency on 2 routes namely CGK-SUB and CGK-DPS to fulfill the extra demand. During the quarter, the company also launched 2 new routes via our latest Hub in Lombok namely LOP-KUL and LOP-PER.

- (5) Revenue Passenger Kilometres (RPK) is a measure of the volume of passengers carried by the airline. Number of passengers multiplied by the number of kilometre these passengers have flown

- (7) Number of aircraft including spares
