



Preliminary Operating Statistics

For the 3rd Quarter 2019

PT AirAsia Indonesia Tbk (“AAID” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce the operating statistics for the 3rd Quarter of the Financial Year 2019 (“3Q19”).

The Company posted a load factor of 85%, up 3 percentage points (“ppts”) as a result of higher growth in passengers carried than capacity which was up by 66% and 61% respectively as compared to the same period last year. Revenue Passenger Kilometres (“RPK”) grew by 63% during the quarter, higher than the growth in Available Seat Kilometres (“ASK”). In line with the Company’s target to increase its domestic presence, the Company launches 6 new routes during the quarter, all being domestic routes. The new routes are Jakarta-Sorong, Jakarta-Lombok, Bali-Lombok, Bali-Labuan Bajo, Lombok-Yogyakarta and Bali-Kertajati which is the replacement for Bali-Bandung route. The Company added 2 more aircraft during the quarter, bringing its total fleet size to 27 as at the end of September 2019.
